Sir,

With reference to the correspondence ending with your letter of 14th June 1918 producing landing certificates for your shipments of foodstuffs to Koweit and Linga per Bagla Sadel Salam Nacoda Mahomed Yusuf in December 1917 I have the honour to state that the landing certificates forwarded show that the 100 bags of sugar for Linga were diverted to and discharged at Koweit. I have therefore to enquire in what circumstances the bags were so diverted and to request you to show cause why you should not be dealt with under Section 167 clause 1 of the Sea Customs Act for misdeclaration of the port of destination in the shipping
